NIP-México invites paper submissions for the 2010 Meeting to be held at the Graduate School for Public Policy (EGAP), Tecnológico de Monterrey, Campus State of Mexico in Mexico City, October 15th, 2010. We welcome theoretical and empirical research relevant for understanding the impact of the current global economic crisis on poverty and inequality and for deriving sound policy recommendations.

For convenience, a list of suggested topics is included in this Call for Papers (see below) which although not exhaustive will serve as a guide for Workshop participants.

A special emphasis will be placed on attracting young scholars from Mexico, Central America and the Caribbean. Students in graduate levels working on related topics are welcome to present proposals. Academics and researchers currently in policy-making positions as well as students in social sciences are welcome to participate in the Meetings if they only want to attend the sessions.

The Conference features keynote speaker Harry Patrinos, who will talk about "Indigenous people, poverty and development". Harry Patrinos is the Lead Education Economist at the World Bank.

The next topics are welcome (although the list is not exhaustive):

- Impact of economic and idiosyncratic shocks on poverty and inequality
- Transmission of poverty and/or inequality
- Returns to education
- Social mobility
- Indigenous poverty and inequality
- Multidimensional poverty and measures
- Program evaluation
- Dynamics of poverty and inequality
- Poverty and natural resources extraction
